

Introduction

The Society's first Newsletter was published in February 1975 by Stephen Marks, the Honorary Secretary, and was designed to replace the intermittent notices sent to members about subscriptions, publications and other arrangements. It was then decided to publish this Newsletter regularly, and the next edition – London Topographical News No 1 – was issued in November 1975, and it has since appeared at regular six monthly intervals.

The Preliminary Issue and numbers 1 to 28 were published between February 1975 and May 1989, and were edited by Stephen Marks. They generally comprised between two to eight A4 pages. The format changed with issue 29 and the publication, now known as the London Topographical Society Newsletter, was expanded so that each edition comprised between 12 to 28 pages. They have all been edited by Dr Penny Hunting, the Newsletter Editor. This format has included more book reviews, notices and also brief original articles.

The November 1999 issue, number 49, was thus the 50th edition of the London Topographical Society Newsletter (counting the first, preliminary issue) and completes 25 years of publication under our two Newsletter editors. It is hoped that this index will assist members and researchers to locate material that will be of interest to them.

A few copies of recently issued *Newsletters* (No. 27 onwards) are available from the Honorary Secretary at £1.50 each. Otherwise, the Publications Secretary will be happy to provide, without charge, a photocopy of any earlier articles which a member may require.
